PM's Internship Scheme



12-month internships are offered.

Interns are covered under **PM Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana.**

A **One-time ₹6,000 grant** to cover incidental expenses.

₹5,000/month via DBT: ₹4,500 from govt, ₹500 from CSR funds.

Youth **aged 21-24, not in full-time jobs or education.**

The scheme boosts youth employability with hands-on experience and multi-sector skill development.

IIT, IIM graduates and those with advanced degrees (MBA, CA) are **ineligible.**

₹2,000 crore for 2024-25, ₹380 crore revised, and ₹10,831 crore allocated for 2025-26.

Supports India's self-reliance by developing a skilled workforce.

₹2 lakh crore allocated for employment and skilling under PM's package.

Managed through an online portal by the **Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA).**

Candidates must have a high school, ITI/polytechnic certificate, or a graduate degree.

Includes sectors like pharma, auto, agriculture, and healthcare.

1 crore youth to intern in top 500 companies over **five years.**
